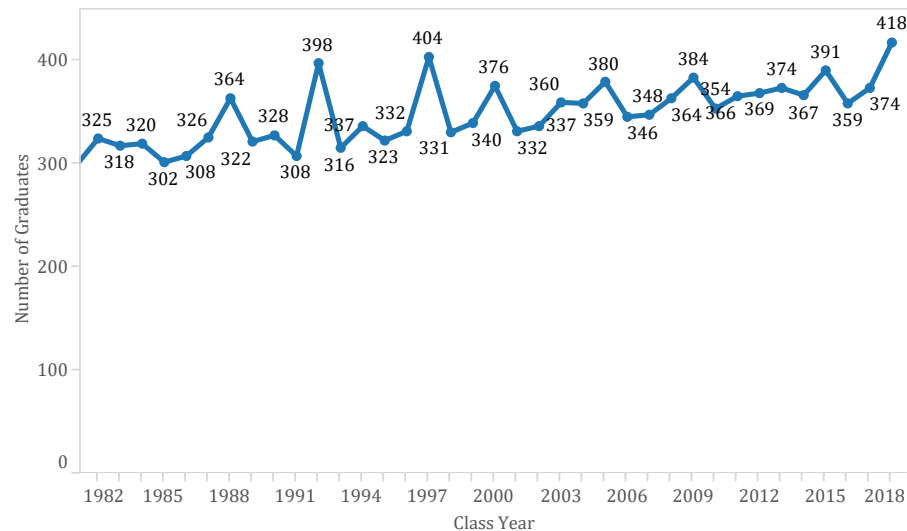

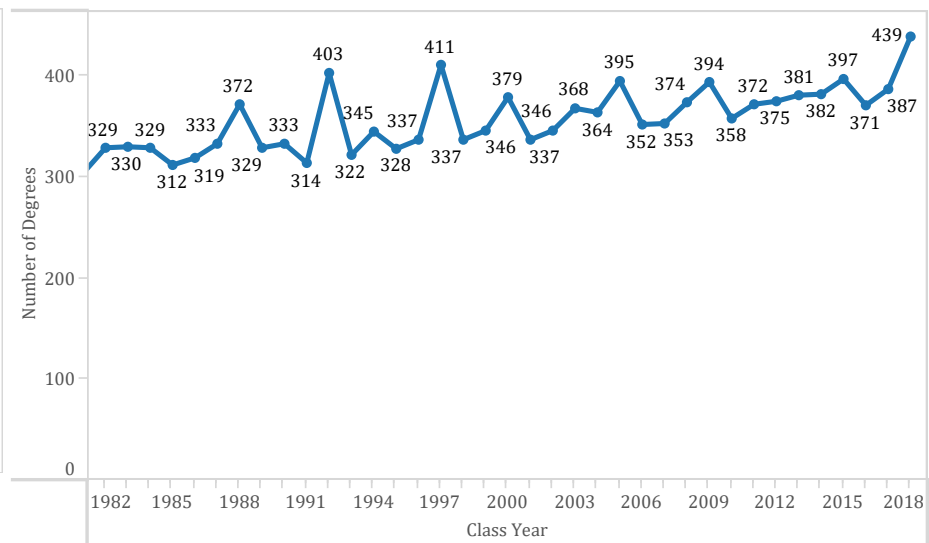

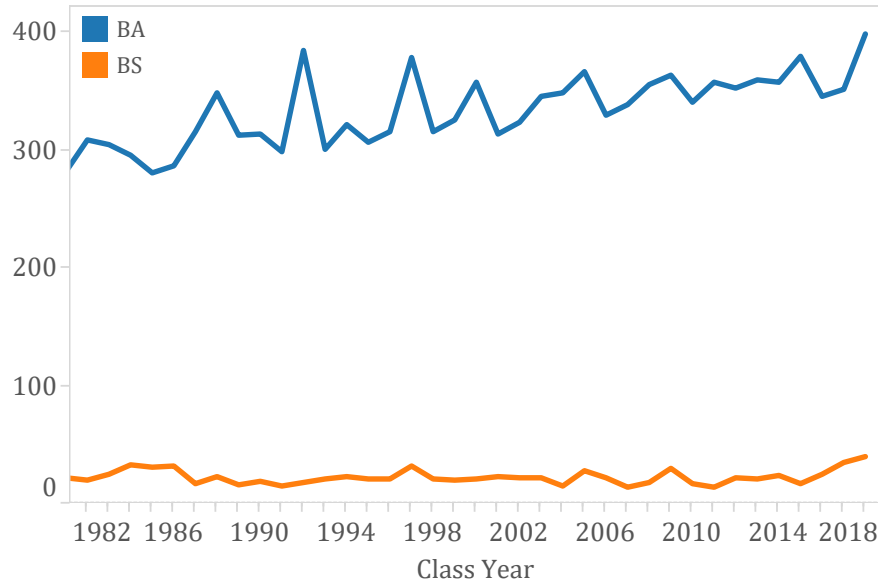
Number of Graduates



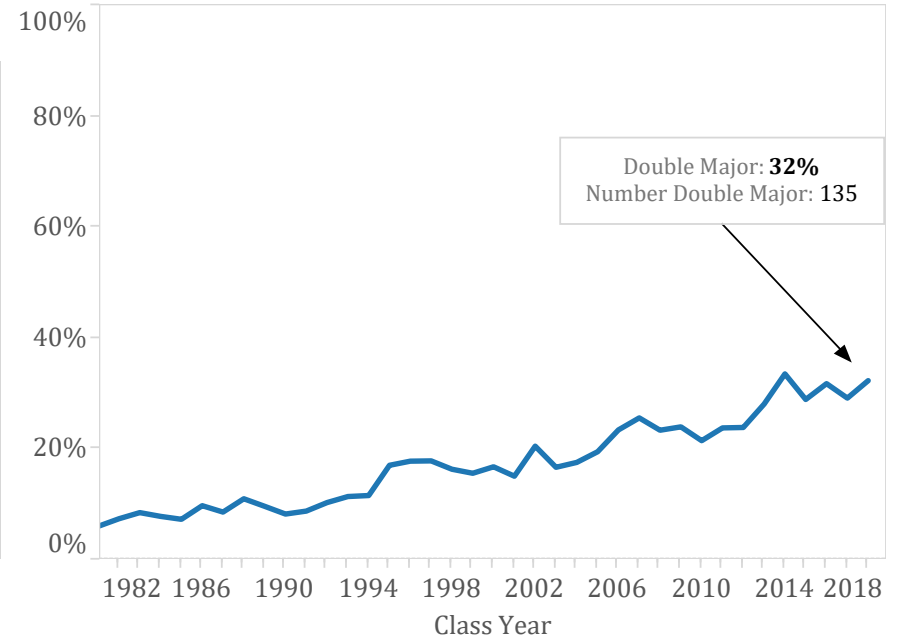
Number of Degrees (BA + BS)



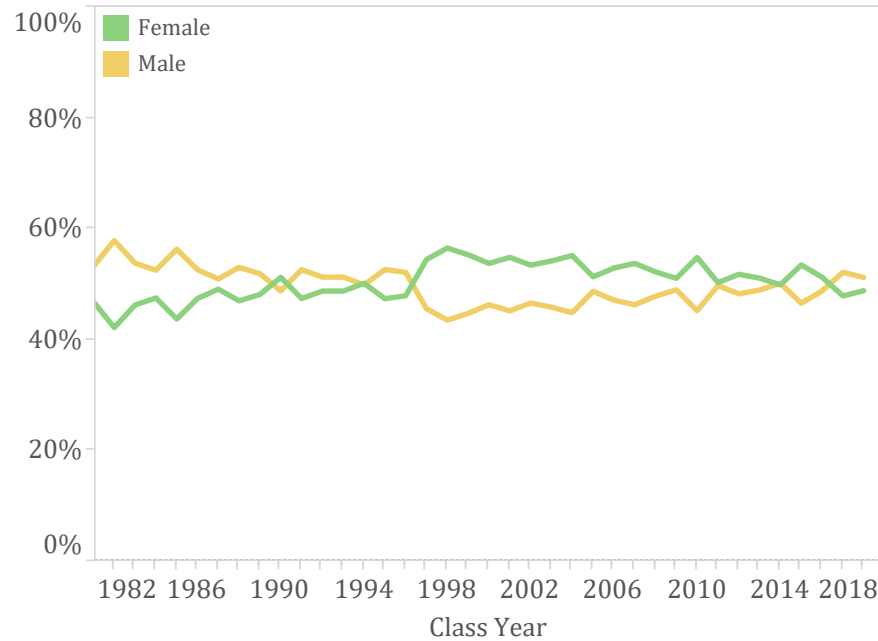

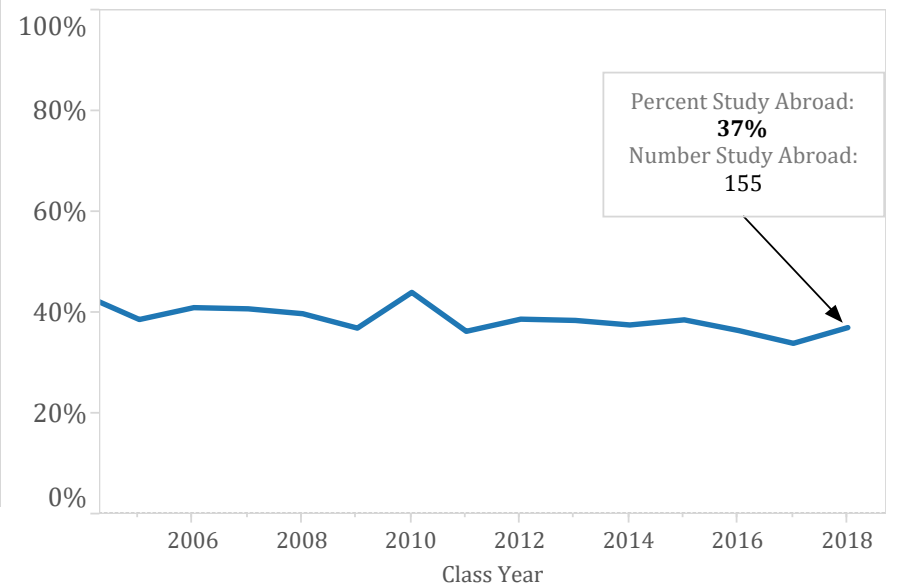
Percent of graduates earning double majors



Percent of Graduates by Gender

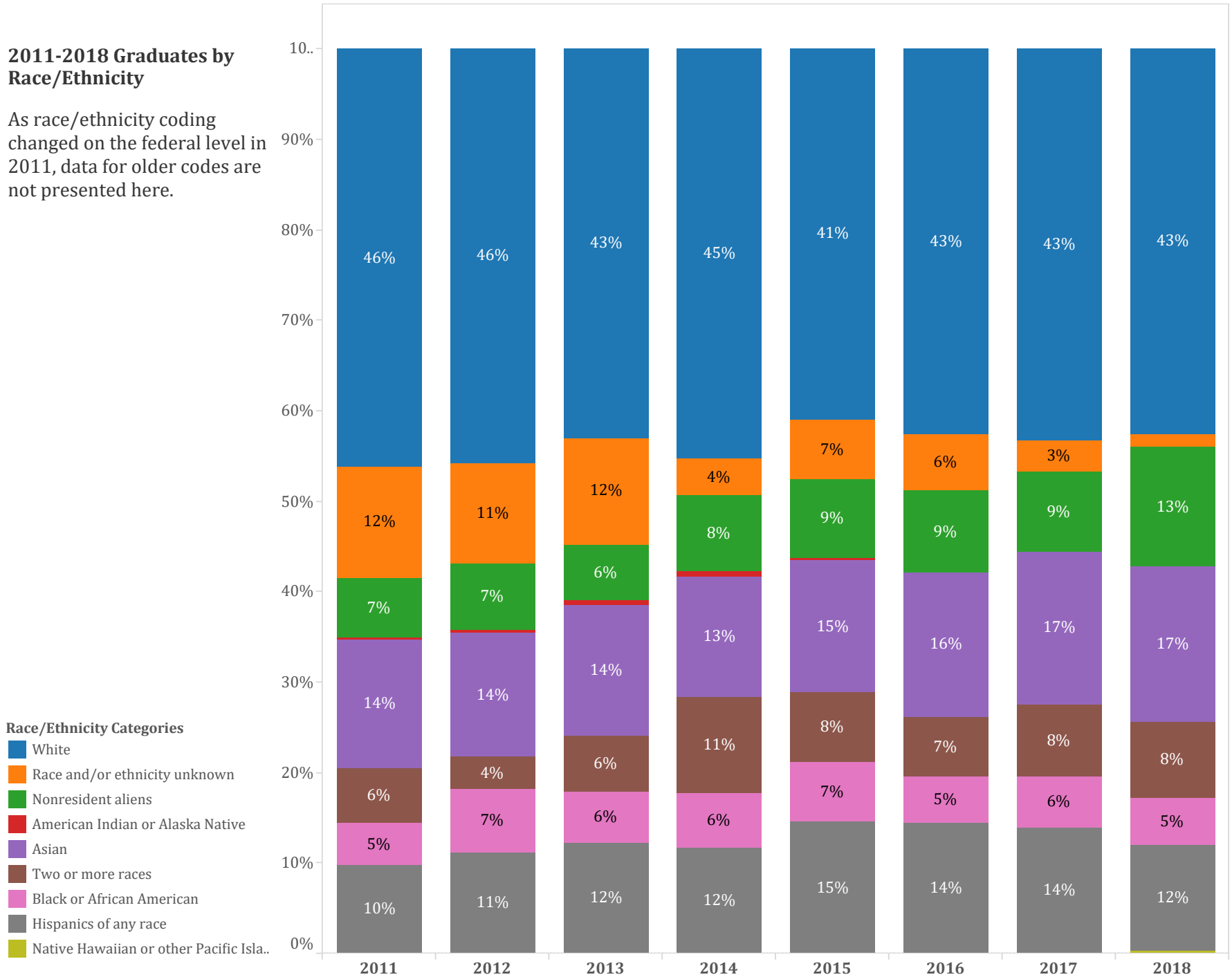


Percent of Graduates Studying Abroad: Graduates are counted here if they studied abroad through Swarthmore for a semester or year. Data is available from 2004 on.



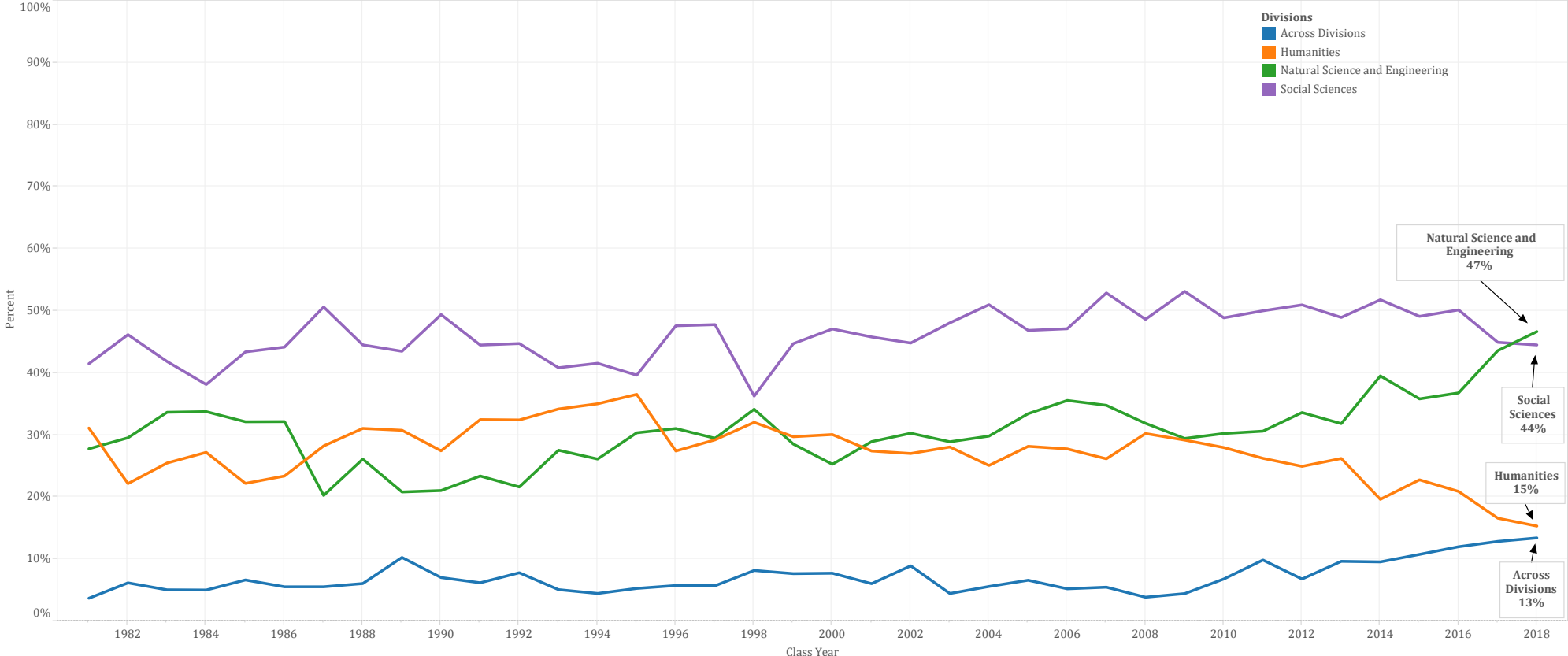
2011-2018 Graduates by Race/Ethnicity

As race/ethnicity coding changed on the federal level in 2011, data for older codes are not presented here.

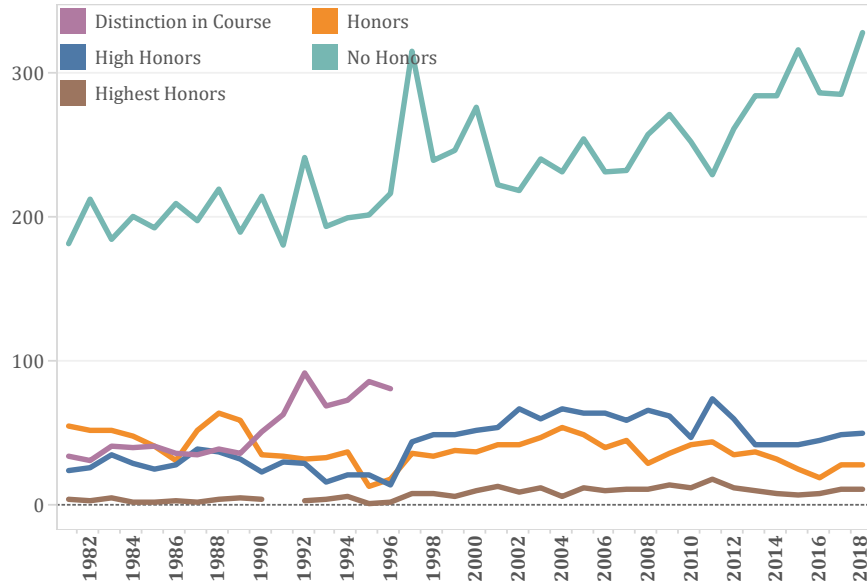

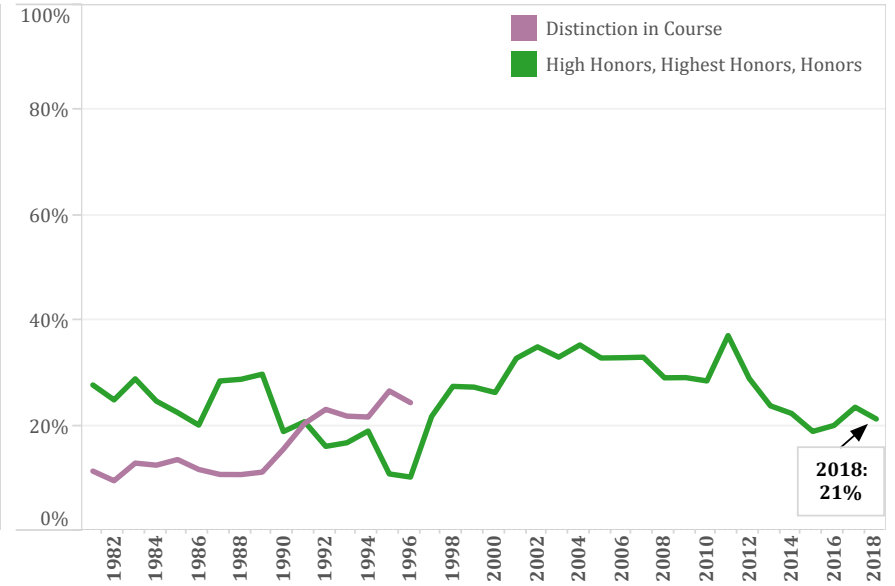
Percent of Graduates with One or More Majors in a Division



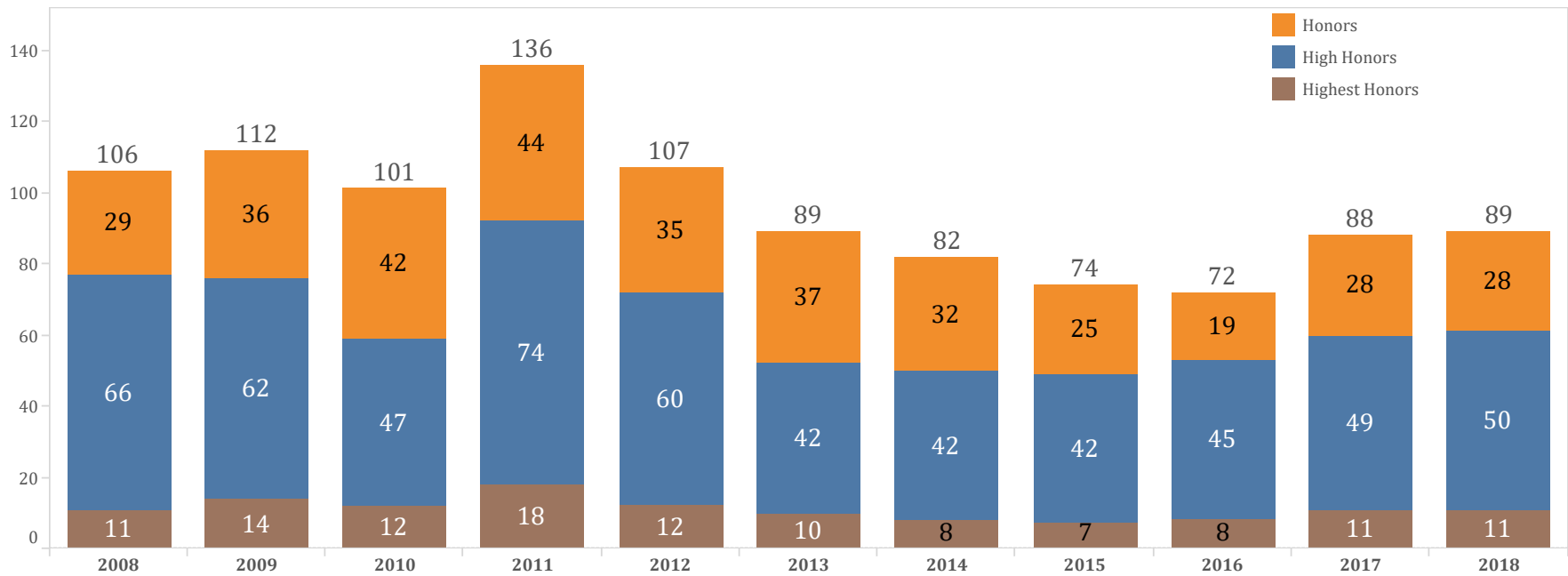
Number of Graduates by Type of Honors



Percent of Swarthmore Graduates Earning Honors or Distinction



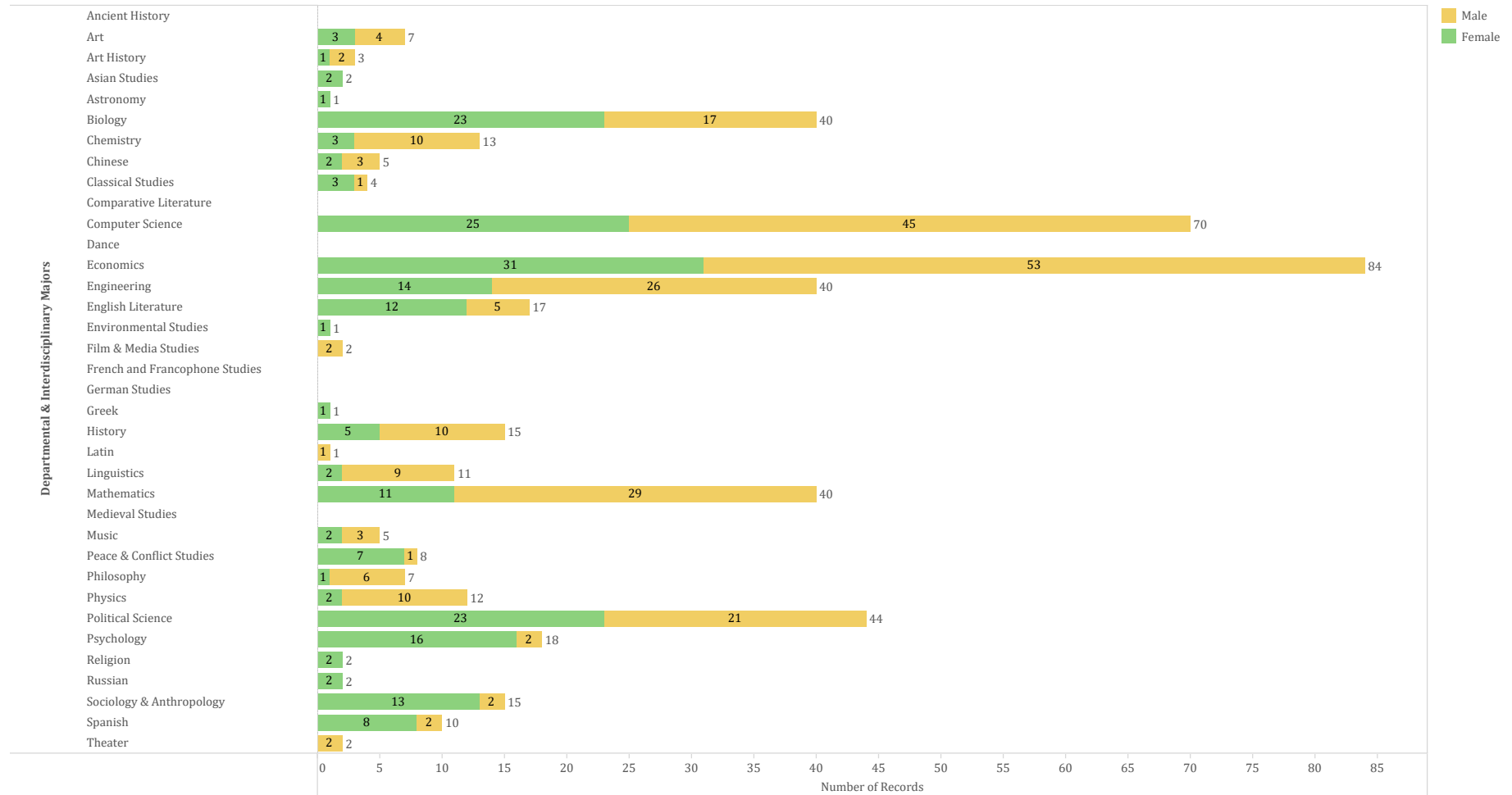
Number of Swarthmore Honors Graduates by Level of Honors

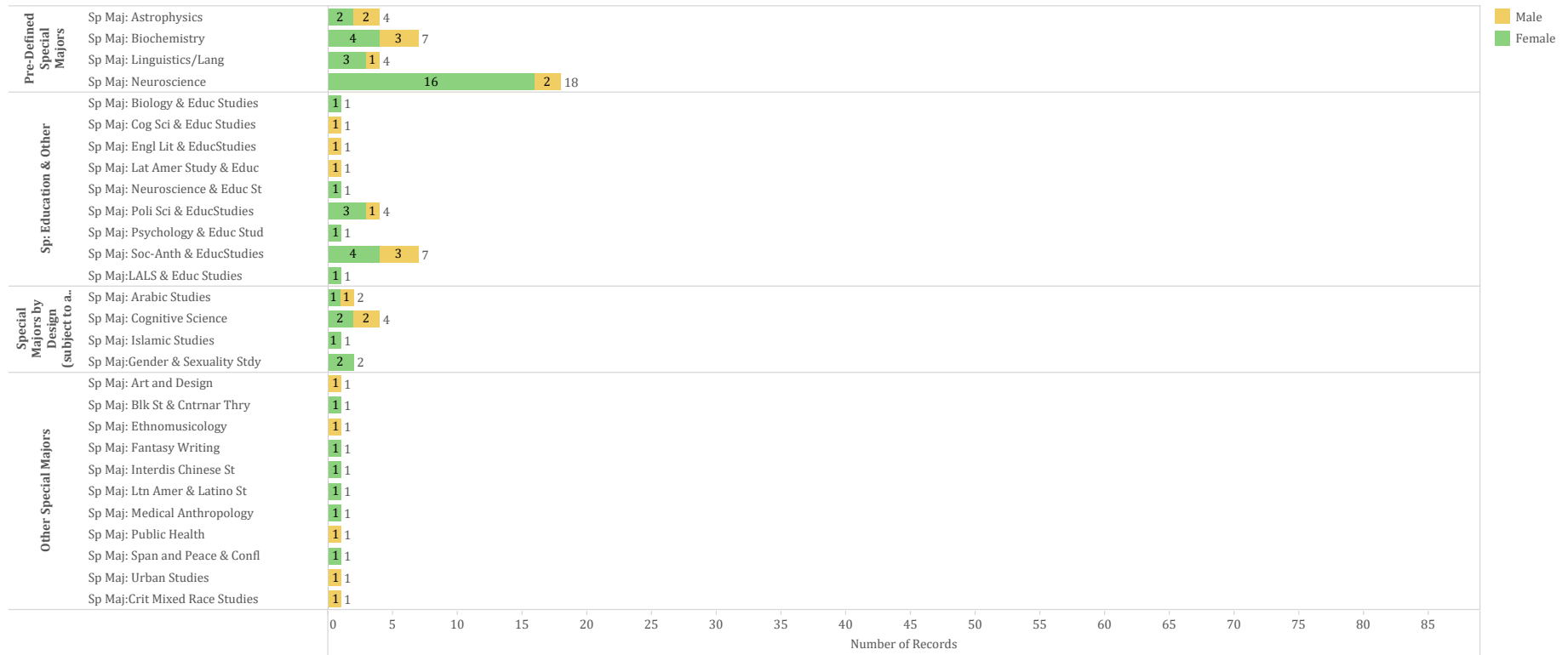

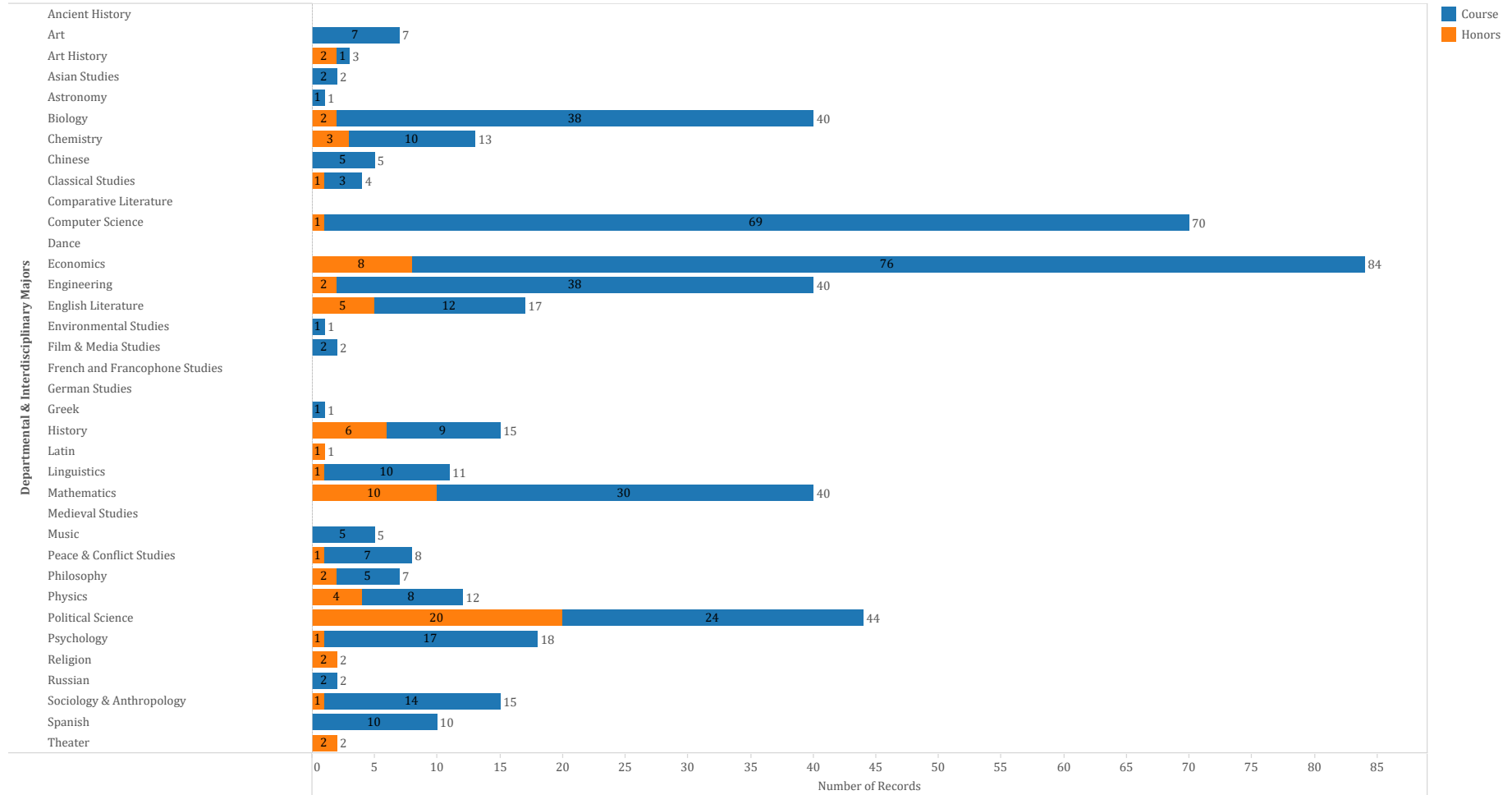

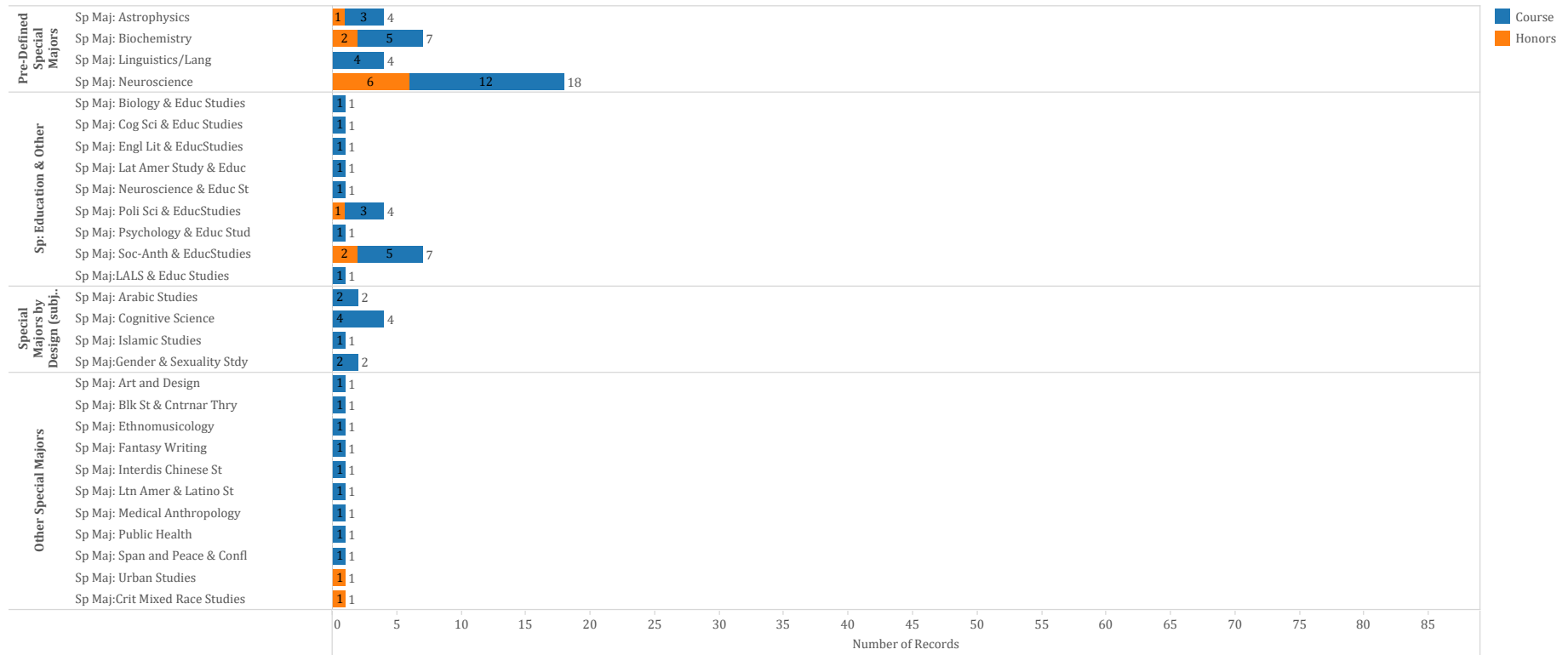
